means that a limited number of patrons can enter the library to browse the shelves, check out and return items, and pay fines.

WHILE WE ARE OPEN FOR GRAB-AND-GO, PATRONS:

- **Must wear masks** (this is mandatory, as per **State guidelines**).

- Must respect capacity limits inside the open locations.
- Make best efforts to limit visits to 15 minutes.
- Must leave location as soon as selections and checkouts are complete.
- Can continue to access programming, eBooks, research databases, classes, and more virtually, via enhanced digital offerings that will remain in place.
